

FULL-TIME NON-TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION IN ACCOUNTING

Applicants must have at least a master's degree or professional certification, a record of excellence in teaching at the undergraduate and/or graduate levels and be an active participant in University service activities. The normal teaching load is 6 courses (3 per semester).
